Highways

My role here primarily involves the direction of tasks to be undertaken by our Parish Steward. The typical jobs undertaken would include the following.

1. Clearing of Lets/gullies on Lodge Hill, thus reducing the amount of rain-water flowing into the Village.
2. Checking and where required clearing the surface road drains.
3. Cleaning road signs and reflectors within the village.
4. Removing weed growth from pavements and kerb side.
5. Repairing minor potholes on highway and pavements.
6. Where necessary cutting back overhanging roads or pavements.

If any of you know of any of the problems please inform me as I cannot be all over the village. I can then request our Steward to investigate and if justified action.

Flood Warden

The Environmental Agency will make telephone contact with me when the ground water level reaches a point where if the rain/snow continues then within 7 to 14 days the level would be higher enough to cause the springs to rise. This warning is known as Flood Watch. At this point I will advise all those known to be directly effected by these springs.

Please refer back to the earlier information I issued last year, which was published in our village magazine.

On the date this report was written, there has not been any flood watch notification issued for this year.
