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Minutes of the Meeting of Tilshead Parish Council held at Tilshead Village Hall on Tuesday the 9th May 2023 at 7pm

Present: Councillors Deborah Potter, Pauline Colin-Peaty, Robert Leachman, Andrew Burbidge, G.C Gillian

In attendance: Rebecca Hathaway-White (Clerk) and three members of the public.

Public Participation 7pm

A resident raised the planning appeal regarding the Rose and Crown pub and the garden shelter they have put up, this is to be discussed by the Parish Council under planning.

A resident raised their concerns regarding the playpark and the lack of cushioning under items like the seesaw after an incident on the weekend where a child fell and hit his head hard on the concrete below the woodchip. There is not enough woodchip over the solid concrete base to provide an adequate cushioning. She asks that the Parish Council look into improving this. Cllr Leachman replied that no concerns were raised at the playpark inspection done recently.

A resident thanked the Parish Council for their support with their solar panels. They are now on appeal and have a barrister on the case. She asked the Parish Council to email their comments to the planning appeal address.

b) Glider Pilot Service Planter – The planter has now arrived back in the village. Cllr Potter reported that the planter will be sited on the triangle with the permission of Highways and there is some groundwork that needs doing first. She will contact Superior Plants to see if they will consider sponsoring it by providing the plants.

c) Playground Zip Wire – Cllr Leachman reported that there is no update as we are still currently waiting to hear back regarding the lottery grant.

d) Emergency Alerts – The Council has been asked to consider participating in a scheme for Community Emergency Contacts and has decided to put all of the Parish Council members forward.

23/73 Local Updates –

a) Environment – Cllr G.C Gillian reported that the notice at the bottom of the lane regarding dog fouling needs replacing. Cllr Colin-Peaty offered to make some new ones up.

b) Police – The Clerk has forwarded emails with updates on local incidences.

c) Military – No update.

d) School – Cllr Burbidge has emailed the Chair of Governors. The Head is leaving at the end of this term and the position is current with EQUA (the academy trust). No applicants have come forward so far. The School are currently working with EQUA to develop risk mitigation if required. Cllr Burbidge suggested opening up communications between the school and the Parish Council and this will be discussed at their next Governors meeting.

Clerk to reply that the bench was moved in September 2020 with permission down to its current location by the bus stop, as the birds were using it as a perch which was causing damage to the bench.
